Supervision

Parents must accept total responsibility for the Supervision and assistance of their child in dressing rooms and while in the pool.

Parents are expected to remain on site for the entire duration of the swimming session. Under no circumstances should children be left waiting unsupervised prior to and following any swimming session particularly in the changing areas.

All children over the age of seven must adhere to the male only policy in the men's dressing rooms, females only in female dressing rooms.

Enclosed is a copy of the Pool Rules/ Safety Guidelines of Bawnmore which we ask that you read for your own information.

Pool Rules

Hygiene Rules of Pool

1. Showers should be taken before and after swimming.
2. Persons with any type of foot infection must not use the pool until cleared to do so by their GP or Chiropodist.
3. All swimmers should ensure that they use the toilet prior to using the pool.
4. No eating in or around pool area.
5. Chewing gum is strictly forbidden in all parts of the Sports Complex.
6. Smoking is strictly forbidden in all areas.
7. Outdoor footwear is not allowed in pool area or in wet areas of the dressing rooms (flip-flops or overshoes should be worn in these areas. Please recycle plastic overshoes whenever possible.
8. Please place litter, shampoo bottles etc. in bins provided.
9. Swimmers entry to pool is through dressing rooms only.

Safety

1. On entry to the Complex all areas can be slippery, especially the dressing rooms and deck area, as such we advise everyone to move slowly to avoid slipping.
2. The dressing room areas are mainly used by swimming groups, because of this they are usually wet, and as such extreme caution should be taken when moving through these areas.
3. Persons who may be in need to assistance in our changing areas or in the pool area itself are advised that they must be accompanied by a helper at all times.
4. The seats in the dressing room areas are for sitting on. Please refrain from standing on seats as you may slip.
5. While in the pool the following points of safety should be observed:
 - No running on deck
 - No pushing, ducking or splashing
 - No horseplay of any kind
 - No screaming ▪ No acrobatics
 - No jumping or diving in any part of the Pool
 - Footballs are not allowed in pool or dressing room areas
 - Glass bottles are not allowed in any part of the Complex
 - Non Swimmers or children in armbands are not allowed to use the deep end of pool unless accompanied on a one to one basis by an adult

Supervision

1. Parents must accept total responsibility for the Supervision and assistance of their child in dressing rooms and while in the pool.

Guideline on use of cameras/mobile phones
